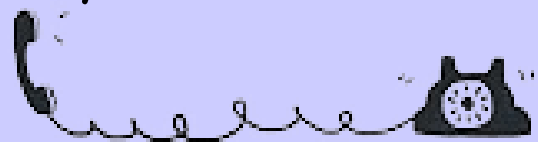
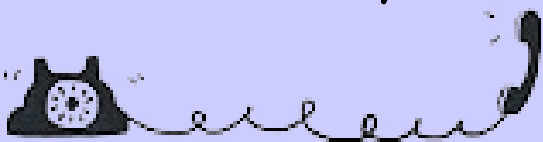


## Pastoral Lead

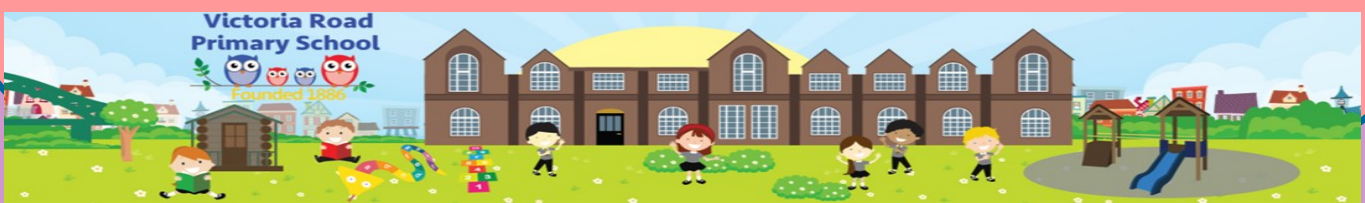

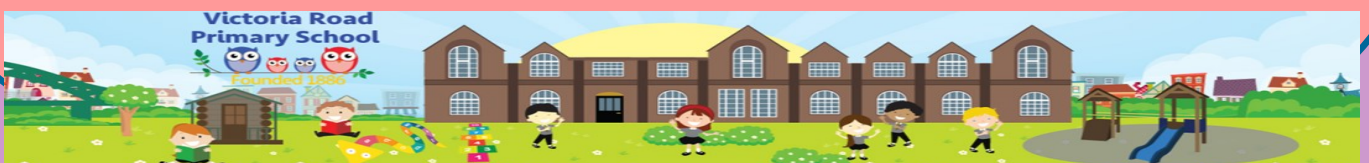
Our employee of the week this week is Mrs Phillips! She has been a great support to Y3 this week and is doing super phonics work.
