Every vote counts so please make sure when you are purchasing anything from Widnes Tesco, you vote for our school!

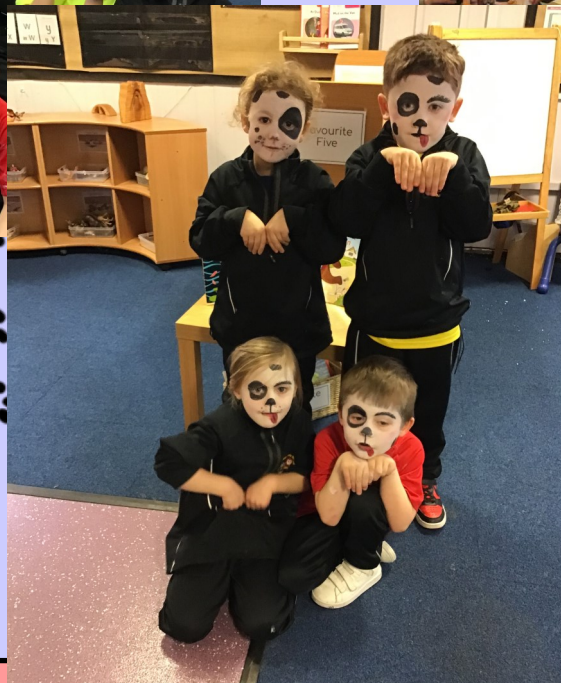

Thank you all for attending our live lessons this week! We hope you all enjoyed them as much as we did.

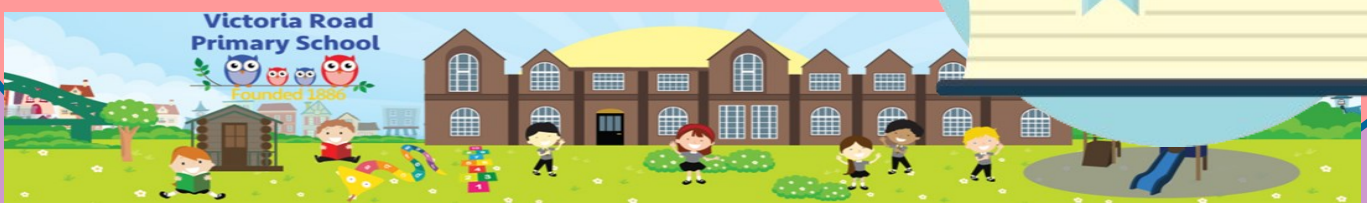
Next week, we have some exciting events on in school for the children. EYFS will be visiting the library on Monday whilst Year 1 and 2 will be visiting on Friday.

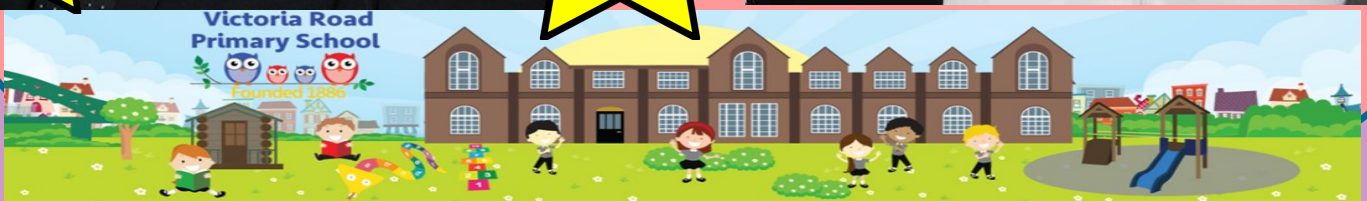
EYFS Reminders

A Message From PTA

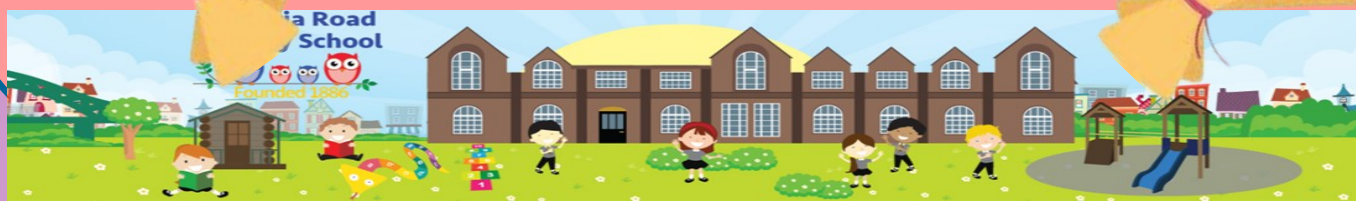
Thank you to all the children for their dedication to Leap Festival yesterday, everyone looked amazing and enjoyed the day!

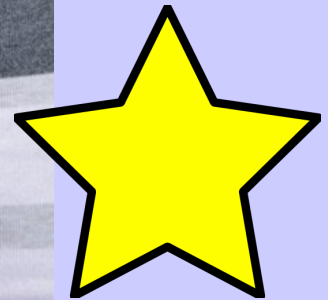
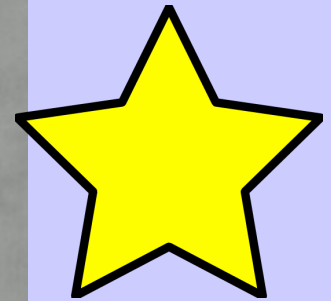

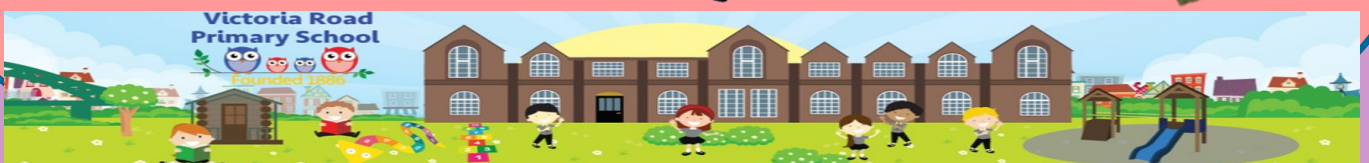
