A message from Rail Safe Friendly:

Simon Frazer, Principal at Guilsborough Academy said;
"The tragic death of Harrison in 2017, when he was in Year 7 at Guilsborough, brought home to our community the importance of teaching our children about safety on the Railways. Schools play a vital role in keeping our children safe. We will never forget Harrison and including rail safety in our curriculum will help to save lives in the future."

On 31st March we launched the Rail Safe Friendly initiative. An initiative that was introduced in partnership with Network Rail, BTP and RSSB to raise safety awareness in all schools and decrease trespassing on the railways.

Switched On is a new rail safety programme for 3-16 year olds that encourages young people to stay Switched On around the railway. 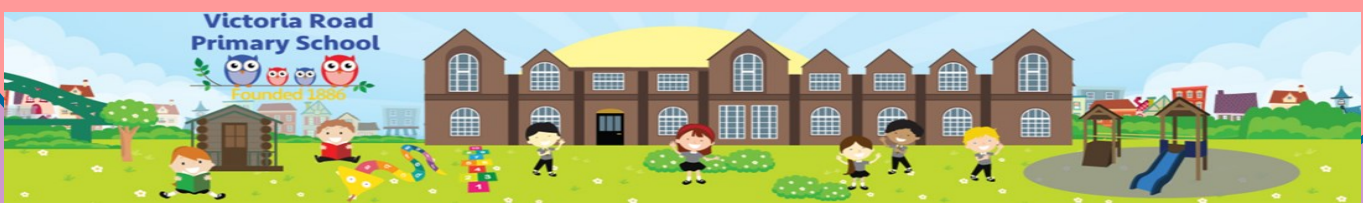
Assessment Week

Sports Day this year will be the 7th June, weather permitting. This will be hosted at the Cricket Club and parents are welcome to come and watch!



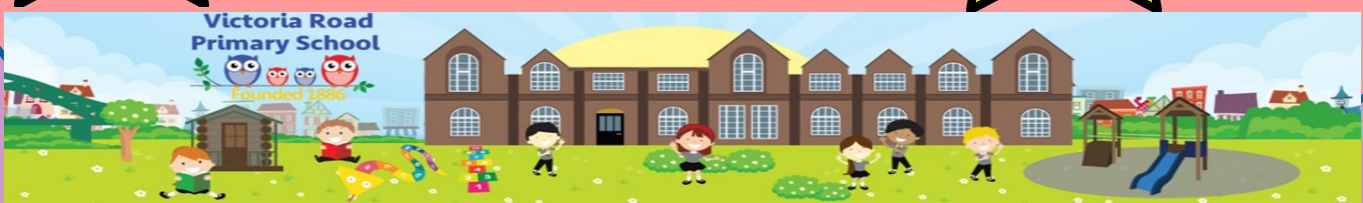

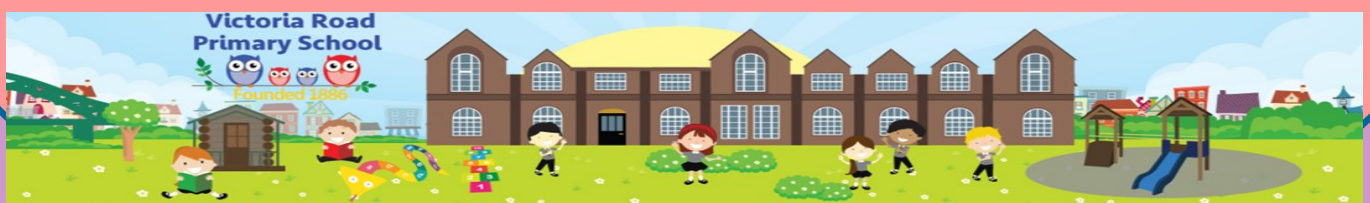

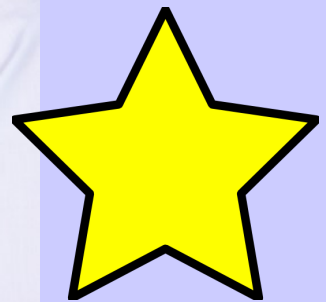
