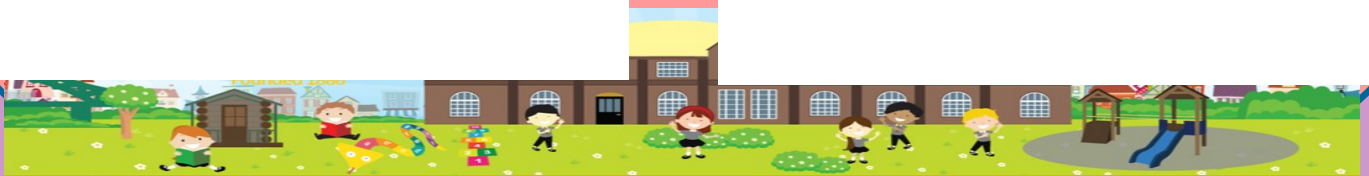

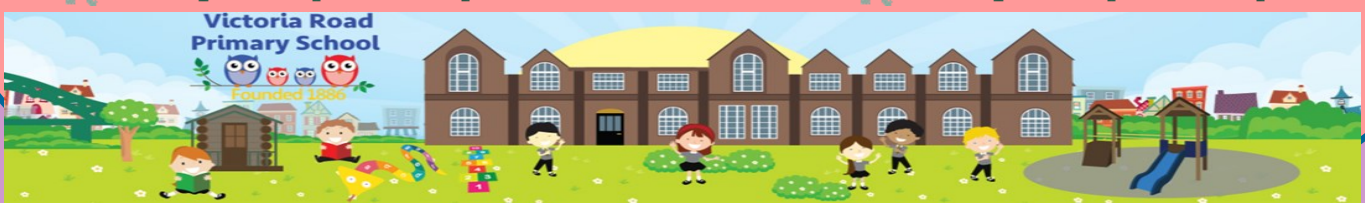
Assessment Week

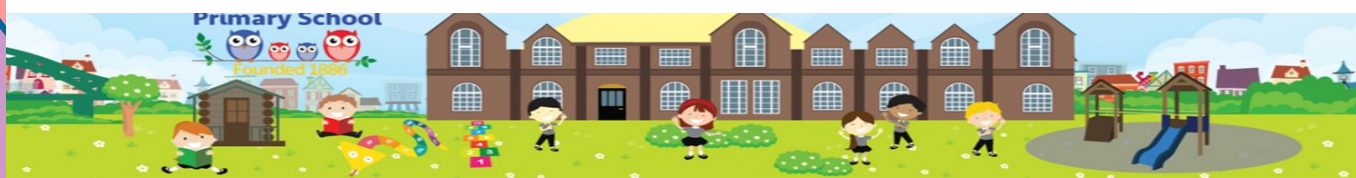
